



Gardens by the Bay is made up of 50 m tall illuminated supertrees, skywalks, water features and conservatory domes. National Parks have spent close to S\$ 800 million building this wonderland in Marina Bay. The climate-controlled conservatories are home to rare plants from across the world, while the supertrees glow in the evening sky in various colors.

Resource Piling installed over 1,500 piles for various structures at Gardens by the Bay. These include the supertrees, the conservatories and the waterfront promenade. Piles ranged from 600 mm to 1,200 mm in diameter. The deepest piles exceeded 60 m.

Gardens by the Bay opened to the public in 2012.
